OH LORD SAVE ME.

David killed Goliath, but he waited for God's salvation. You can have enough strength, enough wealth, be healthy and stable enough in all you are doing but there will come a time where you will seek salvation from God, to protect you in all that you are doing.

Look at your life - maybe you already have a business and then its starts doing badly. You were in good health, then unfortunately you became sick. You will seek God's salvation, to save you from illness or to hinder any obstacles that may lead to your business' failure. David had a lot of energy, and everybody left him, but eventually, his help came from God.

The bible talks about this, (verse 12:2) that everyone lies to his neighbor, that their flattering lips speaks with deception. For you to attain the qualifications for God's salvation you have to be a person who loves to talk about the truth.

There are 3 ways we learn about God's salvation

Slide out from your life:-

When you slide out from your life, everybody leaves you, be it your close friends, your neighbors or even your close relatives. That is the time you will cry for your Lord God to save you. God has powers to remove every problem out of your life, as long as you say "Oh lord save me."

2. God indicates you:-

When God indicates you nobody loses you as long as you say "Oh lord save me". When God chooses you to be their leader, no body can challenge it since his powers indicate your succession and all these will happen when you cry to your Lord for salvation.

3. God gives you the right direction:-

When God shows you the right direction in all that you are doing, in what steps you are undertaking in your life, in all the problems you are passing through, he has the powers to sustain and cover you as long as you say "Oh Lord save me."

In conclusion, God has powers to save you, protect your business and solve all your problems as long as you say "Oh Lord save me." Pray everyday, repent your sins and seek God's salvation for him to save you.
